**List of Approved Identity Source Documents**

<p>The <u>primary</u> identity source document shall be neither expired nor canceled, must be one of the following forms of identification:</p>	<p>The <u>secondary</u> identity source document may be from the list of primary identity sources, but cannot be of the same type as the primary identity source document. The secondary identity source document may also be any of the following:</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• U.S. Passport or a U.S. Passport Card</li> <li>• Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt Card (Form I-551)</li> <li>• Foreign passport that contains a temporary I-551 stamp or temporary I-551 printed notation on a machine-readable immigrant visa</li> <li>• Employment Authorization document that contains a photograph (Form I-766)</li> <li>• Driver's license or an ID card issued by a state or possession of the United States provided it contains a photograph</li> <li>• U.S. Military ID card</li> <li>• U.S. Military dependent's ID card</li> <li>• Department of Defense Common Access Card</li> <li>• Unexpired HSPD -12 PIV ID</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• U.S. Social Security Card issued by the Social Security Administration</li> <li>• Original or certified copy of a birth certificate issued by a state, county, municipal authority, possession, or outlying possession of the United States bearing an official seal</li> <li>• ID card issued by a Federal, state, or local government agency or entity, provided it contains a photograph</li> <li>• Voter's registration card</li> <li>• U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner card</li> <li>• Certificate of U.S. Citizenship (Form N-560 or N-561)</li> <li>• Certificate of Naturalization (Form N-550 or N-570)</li> <li>• U.S. Citizen ID Card (Form I-197)</li> <li>• ID Card for use of Resident Citizen in the United States (Form I-179)</li> <li>• Certification of Birth Abroad or Certification of Report of Birth issued by the Department of State (Form FS-545 or Form DS-1350)</li> <li>• Unexpired Temporary Resident Card (Form I-688)</li> <li>• Unexpired Employment Authorization Card (Form I-688A)</li> <li>• Unexpired Reentry Permit (Form I-327)</li> <li>• Unexpired Refugee Travel Document (Form I-571)</li> <li>• Unexpired employment authorization document issued by Department of Homeland Security (DHS)</li> <li>• Unexpired Employment Authorization Document issued by DHS with photograph (Form I-688B)</li> <li>• Driver's license issued by a Canadian government entity</li> <li>• Native American tribal document</li> </ul>

**Note:** Departments and agencies may choose to accept only a subset of the identity source documents listed above. For example, if the primary source document is a foreign passport (e.g., Italy), the secondary source document should not be another foreign passport (e.g., France). Also, if the name on a birth certificate that is being used for badging is different from the name on the photo ID of the applicant, an additional court document showing the name change must be provided.

IHS requires one document from Column A and one document from Column B.
